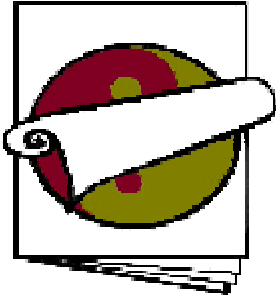

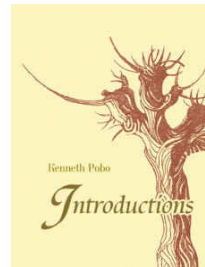


Three New Titles from Pearl's Book 'em Publisher

Publisher collection in his new book of poetry entitled, "Introductions."

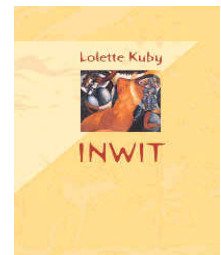
